SUNDAY GOSPEL REFLECTION (LUKE 1:1- 4; 4:14 - 21)

In his Apostolic letter dated September 30, 2019, “*Aperuit illis*,” Pope Francis established that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is to be the Sunday of the Word of God. Sunday of the Word of God is a day to be devoted to the celebration, study, and spreading the Word of God.

In today’s Gospel reading, we see Jesus returning to his hometown of Nazareth, entering the synagogue, and reading from a familiar text from the prophet of Isaiah. “*the Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor... to acclaim liberty to*

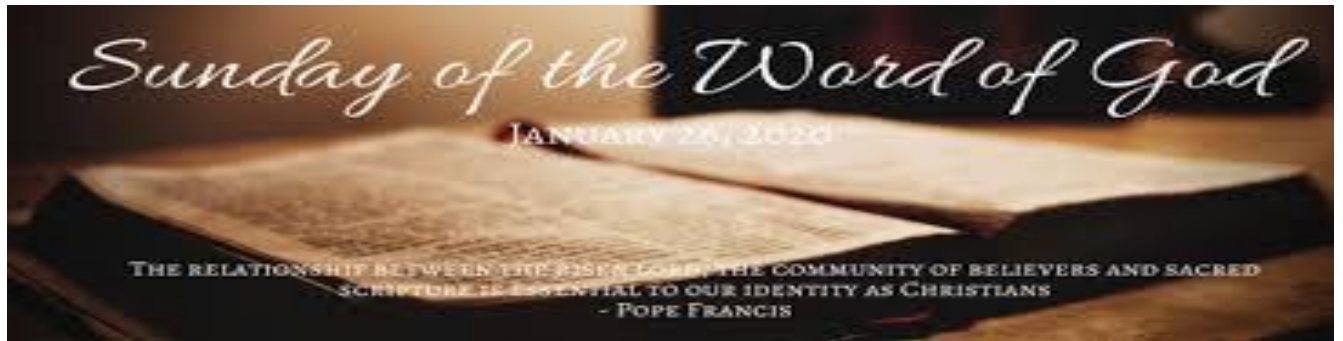

capitves... recovery of sight to the blind... to let the oppressed go free... Inspiring, holy, profound and then he said, "Today's scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." Jesus is telling the people of Nazareth that these words, they are familiar with, these mysterious versus about so-called anointed one... are about him.

The list of things that this long-awaited anointed one will be accomplishing sounds like the God we've come to know throughout our lives would be about. It may not make sense to those listeners two thousand years ago, but it should not sound that unusual to our ears today, especially after centuries of reflection on the person of Jesus and in light of his death and Resurrection.

What Jesus is telling us, we have a responsibility to build up the faith and strengthen it. By our baptism, we are signing to something and to someone, and that someone is Jesus. That we will unite ourselves to him and to all he stood for. When we hear Jesus articulate his mission, we are also listening to him articulate our mission too. Bringing glad tidings, proclaiming liberty, giving sight to the blind, freeing the oppressed, this not just God-stuff, this is our stuff, our responsibility. Our mission can be overwhelming, but as Paul wrote, there are many parts. We don't have to do everything ourselves. Each of us just needs to do his or her part. Do something. Doing nothing is not an option.

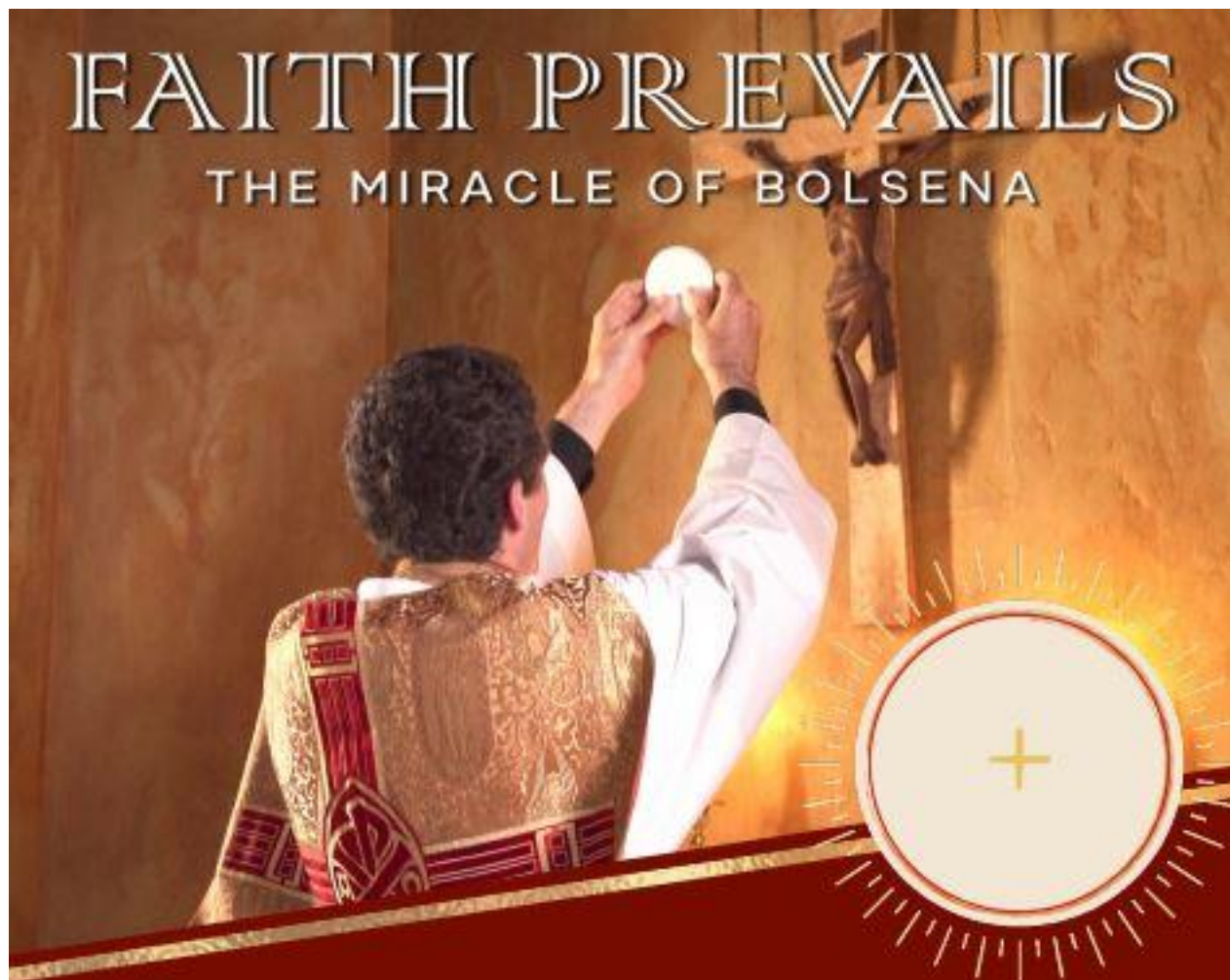

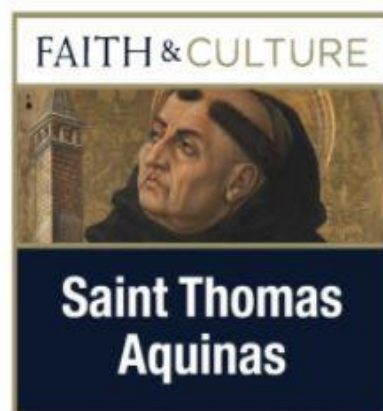
