WORLDWIDE CONSECRATION OF RUSSIA AND UKRAINE TO THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

In the light of the tragic invasion of Ukraine by Russia, our Holy Father, Pope Francis, has decided to pray a Prayer of Consecration of Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary at a Penance Service at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome at 5:00 p.m., Rome time (**6:00 a.m. Hawaii time**) on **Friday, March 25**, the Solemnity of the Annunciation. All will be asked to participate in this worldwide prayer for peace. The Holy See will soon send the text of the prayer, which we will share as soon as it is received.





FR. ANTHONY'S STEWARDSHIP CORNER (THE SPIRITUALITY OF STEWARDSHIP)

Stewardship is spirituality rather than theology. So, what is the difference?

Theology is a series of facts and ideas that are lined to each other by logic. Theology is something that you can think your way through. It is very much a product of the brain. It is mind oriented.

You can't think your way through the spirituality of stewardship. Logic doesn't come into play, it is a faith response of a disciple of Christ and is guided, in a large part, by your personal relationship with God.

Jesus offers the parable of the fig tree to further illustrate this truth. The owner of the orchard came searching for fruit on a fig tree he had planted in his orchard. Finding no fruit on the tree after three years, he told the gardner to cut it down. But the gardener intercedes and asks for one more year to cultivate and fertilize the tree in hopes it would bear fruit in the future. The fig tree was not dying; it simply wasn't doing much of anything at all. Can this be said of us and our lives as well?

The season of Lent is a time to carefully reflect on the way we spend our time. Do we make God our first priority, tending to our spiritual growth and sacramental life with diligence? Do we give the next priority, tending to our spiritual growth and sacramental life with diligence? Do we give the next priority to our loved ones, focusing intentionally on them each day without distractions from phones, screens, or thoughts of work? If not, now is the moment to repent of our waste of time or of misplaced priorities on our use of time. God is merciful but just. Let's turn to Him and ask Him to make our lives fruitful while we still have time to do so.

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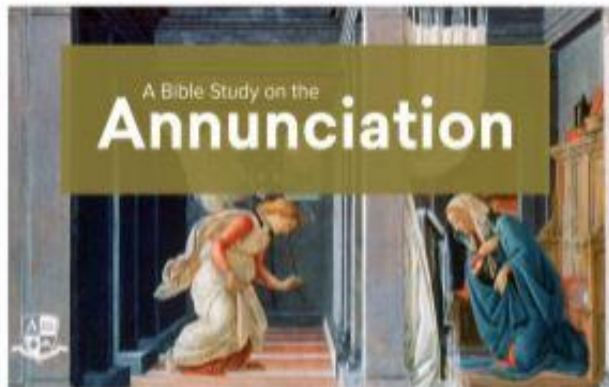

A BIBLE STUDY ON THE ANNUNCIATION

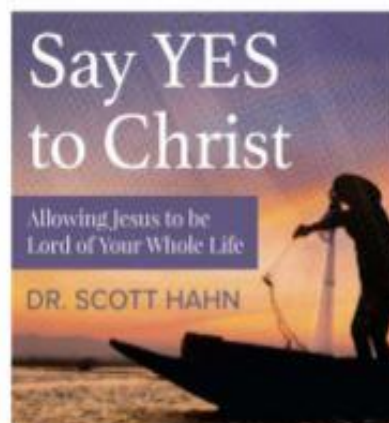
