## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

***"I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." [John 6:57]***

The Bishops of the United States are calling for a three-year grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. They believe that God wants to see a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—and sent out in mission "for the life of the world." These three distinct years are divided into three themes: Diocesan Year, Parish Year, and Year of Going out in Mission.

Over the next three years, we the people of God, and the parish of St. John's, will be embarking on a Spirit-led revival which will begin on Sunday June 19, 2022, the Feast of Corpus Christi. I will be publishing our St. John Apostle and Evangelist Church Mission Plan to Living Out the National Eucharistic Revival in the near future. Please keep in mind we will adapt our plan to include all Diocesan policies, materials, events, and requests for the Diocesan Year. Also, I will be adding a new tabernacle to our main worship space. It will be located directly behind the main altar. This change will allow our parish to fully embrace the meaning of section 1324 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church which states:

*"The Eucharist is 'the source and summit of the Christian life.' [LG 11.] 'The other sacraments, and indeed, all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch.'"*

According to the various parish documents I have read since becoming your pastor, "the vision of St. John Apostle & Evangelist Church is to continually strive to become a Spirit-led stewardship parish." Our Mission Statement published in our parish bulletin every weekend state: "WE ARE A CATHOLIC COMMUNITY – called to develop a deeper relationship with Christ. Such a relationship is fostered through active participation in: Word, Sacrament, Renewal Programs, Ministry/Service, and other Spirit-led activities." We will continue to accomplish this by achieving our parish goals for this first year of this revival.

## STEWARDSHIP BULLETIN REFLECTION (JOHN 20:19 - 23)

Today, we reach the finale of the Easter season with the celebration of the great Feast of Pentecost. Reflecting on today's readings inspires a sense of awe as we consider the mighty power of the Holy Spirit at work giving birth to and sustaining our Church. Just as awesome — the same Spirit is calling to us this day to take up our part in the Church's saving work.

In the first reading, from Acts, we see the creative genius of the Holy Spirit moving through the newly confirmed Apostles "who began to speak in different tongues as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim." The large crowd, gathered from all over the world were "amazed" and "astounded" that each one could understand the Apostles speaking in their own language.

Each one of us, young and old alike, is personally called today by the Holy Spirit into the same mission as that of the first Apostles — to advance the Kingdom of God in our corner of the world. Just as He did on that Pentecost day, the Holy Spirit speaks to us in our "own language" to give us the Good News of the Gospel and urge us to share it. We can think of our own language as the particular gifts, talents, and passions we possess. We experience the presence of the Holy Spirit through them, and we are meant to put them to the work in grateful service of the Kingdom of God.

When we consider the stewardship way of life we are called to live, we often focus on the challenges it poses. Surrendering ourselves to God is indeed a challenging way to live. But it leads to a life that is exciting, creative, and deeply rewarding. Stewardship allows us to experience life as a great adventure because it is a life guided and directed by the very source of power and creativity — the Holy Spirit!

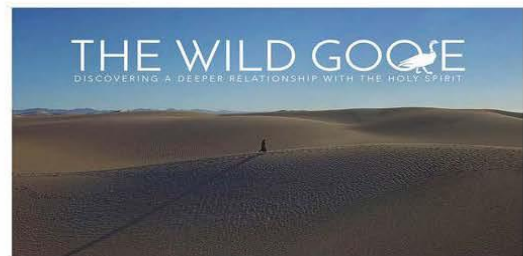
