SUNDAY GOSPEL REFLECTION

This Sunday's gospel passage is filled with beautiful statements about the ever-popular subject of **love**. It also compels us to look deeper. Love is Christ's great message to his followers – his parting word and it is profound. "As the Father loves me, so I also love you," Jesus said. How deep and how eternal that love must be. But Jesus at once followed that statement with a bold and unimaginable challenge.

"Love one another," he commanded, "as I have loved you."

In other words: As deeply as God loves His son, and as powerfully as Jesus then loves us, that is how we are to love one another. Despite our differences, love one another. Despite the hurt someone has caused us, love one another. Despite the angers we are nursing or the grudge we can't let go of... love one another.

Could any commandment be more difficult? Could any order be harder to follow? Christ is asking us to do nothing less than to love the world the way that God does. The great challenge of this Sunday's gospel is to look at the world around us, the people around us — all those we like and those we don't, those we care for and those we don't, those we respect and those we don't — and love them like that, too.

"Love one another as I have loved you."

This is our calling – and Christ's great commandment.

"I love you all!"

What will Happen on Pentecost Weekend?

On Pentecost weekend, St. Apostle & Evangelist parish along with several other parishes in the Diocese of Honolulu will implement the Original Order of the Sacraments of Initiation. The Religious Education Department under the leadership of its Director of Religious Education (DRE), staff, volunteer team, aides have been working forming our children and youth along with their parents and godparents in preparation for this implementation. We still have a few more sessions before May 19/20:

- ❖ May 9, Practice for First Reconciliation, Confirmation & Eucharist (FRCE), 6-8pm.
- ❖ May 12, EDGE and Life Teen Students & Sponsors, 9am-12pm.
- ❖ May 16, FRCE Students & Sponsors, 6-8pm.
- ❖ May 19, 5pm Mass: FRCE Students will receive Sacraments of Confirmation & First Holy Communion. Msgr. John will preside.
- ❖ May 20, 9am Mass: Students in grades 3-5 will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Students & Sponsors report by 8am. Picture taking begins at 8:15am. Fr. Joseph will preside.
- ❖ May 20, 11am Mass: EDGE & Life Teen Students will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Students & Sponsors report by 10am. Picture taking begins at 10:15am. Msgr. John will preside.

I take the opportunity to thank all parents and sponsors for journeying with your children. Please remember that the journey continues after confirmation with mystagogy sessions, which will present post-confirmation catechesis and help entry into parish ministry. READINGS FOR NEXT SUNDAY, MAY 13, 2018

First Reading: Acts 1:1-11

This text narrates the Ascension of the Risen Lord into heaven and the beginning of witness by the apostles starting from Jerusalem to the ends of the earth. Before his ascension the Risen Lord assures them that “you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you.” As Jesus ascends, the disciples are described as being perplexed and filled with anxiety about their role in witnessing “why are you standing there looking at the sky?” That rhetorical question is a hint that they should get on with their task given them by the Lord. Jesus who ascends to heaven will return in the same way the apostles have seen him go up.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 47:2-3, 6-7, 8-9

Psalm 47 is a processional song of exaltation that proclaims God’s rule over all the peoples of the earth. Response: “God mounts his throne to shouts of joy; a blare of trumpets for the Lord.”

Second Reading: Ephesians 1:17-23

The Ascension celebrates the exaltation or glorification of Christ rather than merely his departure. Enthroned at God’s right hand, he is more than just the object of our worship. The Risen Lord in his new existence is the source of our new creation. His position is not so much that of domination as that of sharing life with us.

Gospel: Mark 16:15-20

This ending of Mark’s Gospel, which in all probability was not part of the original writing, shows how Jesus remains present with his Church from the very beginning. By his power, the disciples will manifest the same signs of the presence of God’s kingdom that Risen Lord has revealed to his followers. The important thing here is not the sign itself — different signs may be appropriate for different times — but the faith that is God’s gift. The text here underlines what is known as “the Great Commission.” Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature.” When the Church proclaims and lives the Gospel, and bears witness to the presence of Christ, the Lord himself is at work.
