"It (the kingdom of God) is like a mustard seed . . . the smallest of all the seeds . . . (but) it springs up and becomes the largest of plants."

In today's Gospel, Jesus uses a parable that his disciples are familiar with and one they will readily understand. He draws their attention to the fact that if one only considered the size of a mustard seed, one could never predict what it would grow into. This tiny, little, undistinguished thing winds up being so much larger than could ever have been expected. To the disciples, the fact that something so insignificant could bring about something much more significant probably seemed like a little miracle. God just had to be behind such a thing.

And so it is with us. We might think that, in order to be faithful disciples of Jesus, we must do the "big" things - things that get our name on a public park or the facade of a building. Or we might think that we must volunteer for everything for which we are asked. All good things. All necessary and worthwhile and important. But are these the only things? Is this the only way to be faithful?
