"They woke him and said to him, 'Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?'"

Do you ever worry that the world is a little out of control?

A little over a year ago, we were confronted with some pretty unsettling thing—the onset of a deadly virus, the outbreak of widespread unrest on our nation's streets, economic turmoil, etc. We know what it was like and what we felt and what dominated our thoughts. Will we ever get through this pandemic? Will the riots and looting stop? Was the world falling apart?

And with these events came a phrase that had been used a few times before but now was being used by almost everyone. And that phrase was: **"The New Normal."** And most of us used those words only in one sense - in a negative way. Many of us looked around and thought, "I wonder if the way things are now is going to be how things will be for a very long time."

Jesus' disciples ask as they are faced with a scary situation in a story familiar to all of us. And his question to his disciples reveals his answer.

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"Do you not yet have faith?" The disciples were in a pretty bad situation and seemingly weren't that sure that things would get better. It's not that they lacked hope or trust or faith completely. It's just that when things got really tough, they allowed the storm around them, allowed the present moment to take over and dominate their minds and thoughts. We would probably be thinking the same thing.

Jesus stepped in and made things better, calmed the storm - took what was chaotic and frightening, and transformed it into something much different - something full of calm, peace, and safety.

We must have hope and trust and have faith that every single thing in this world can be made better. Today is simply that. Tomorrow can be whatever God wants it to be and whatever we are willing to do our part to help bring about. There are no limits to the good God can bring about from any challenge or struggle we are having- whether that be something happening around us, or most importantly, the things that are happening within us.

When our faith is truly alive within us we will never consider anything to be **"the new normal."** Rather, each day is an opportunity - an opportunity to work with God to calm the storms around us and within us, helping bring about a peace that only God can give.

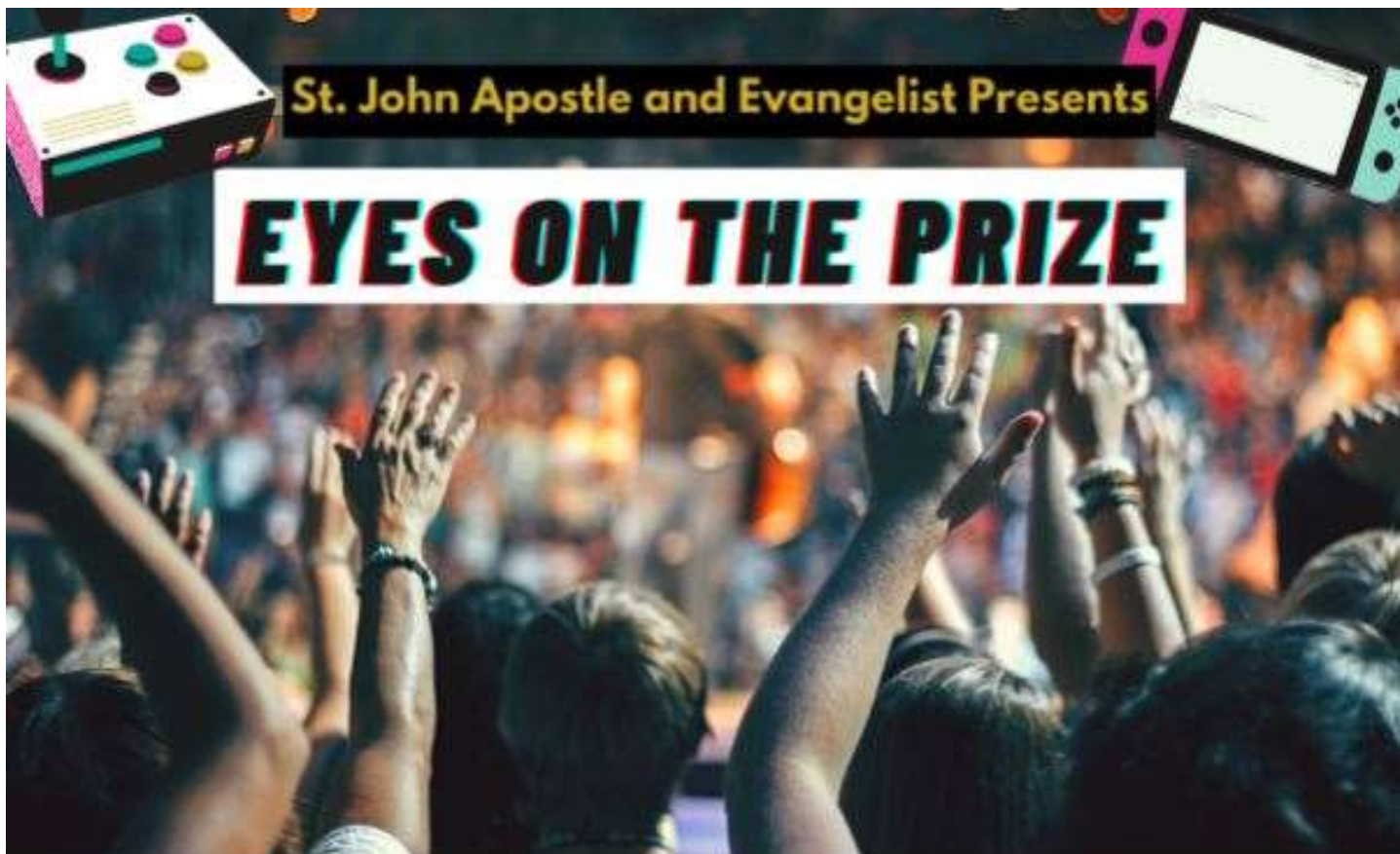
