"Gather the fragments left over so that nothing will be wasted."

This Gospel reading passage today seems like that Jesus does not like to waste - at least that's the picture we might get from the Gospel. Jesus, after feeding the multitude from what started out as five loaves and two fish, instructs his disciples to collect the fragments that are left over after everyone has had their fill. Why? Why does Jesus not want anything wasted? Maybe it's because Jesus does not like to waste for the exact same reason as you and me; that we tend to try not to waste things for the simple reason that we don't want things to run out, so we turn off lights and water faucets and those sort of things to protect things that are limited.

God, on the other hand, doesn't waste because what he knows is unlimited, because what he knows is possible; because he knows that the things that really matter can never run out. God simply wastes nothing - not because he fears there won't be enough, but because he knows that something good can always come from every situation - no matter how small, hopeless, or unlikely it may seem. Isn't that incredible? Our loving, compassionate, all-powerful God can take anything and somehow bring more out of it - whether that be a person, an obstacle, a joy, a heartache, or even five loaves and two fish. God can use absolutely do anything and everything (for his purposes of course).
