**NEW PARISHIONERS & VISITORS, WELCOME TO OUR PARISH!****SUNDAY GOSPEL REFLECTIONS****By: Deacon Romeo Ganibe**

Two weeks ago, we heard in the Gospel reading, Jesus' feed over five thousand with five loaves and two fish. In my homily, I talked about how God wastes nothing, how he can accomplish wonderful things with very little - even the little fragments left over we find in ourselves at times - our weaknesses, our limitations, and yes, even our sin. From our own brokenness God can feed the world.

In today's Gospel, Jesus said,

***"... and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."***

Jesus gave his flesh - gave his very self in love - to give life to the world, not to provide life at some point in the future, but to shower it upon us right now, in this time and place, to me and to you. Jesus shared his life with the world in a perfect way two thousand years ago, and he continues to do so, completely, continually, and without limit. And why? Why does Jesus keep pouring his life into the world? Why does he give himself to us as real food at this sacred table? Simply, so that we can be fully alive, fully transformed by his love, mercy, compassion, and generosity - that is, by his very life poured out for us and into each of us.

And so, Jesus gives us his flesh as real food for the journey so that we in turn can become (in ways that can be difficult to comprehend) the Body of Christ, and in imitation of him, give our flesh - that is, lay down our lives, for the life of the world. Jesus gave his life so that we might have life. And now he asks us to give our lives to and for others in precisely the same way - unconditionally.

### **Email from God**

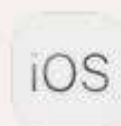
