Preschool / Religious Education **Surveys**

- Education is the largest user of space on campus
- Needed to survey stakeholders in education
- Survey design by Hawaii Catholic Schools
- Included parents, teachers/catechist and Preschool board
- Survey used an independent process

Preschool / Religious Education Surveys

Group	Sent	Responses	Percentage
Preschool Parents	91	27	29.67%
Preschool Board	6	5	83.33%
Preschool Teachers/Aides	9	6	66.67%
RE Parents	166	66	39.76%
RE Catechist/Aides	41	17	41.46%
Total	313	121	38.66%

- More hands-on activities, e.g. arts and crafts, etc.
- More Bible study.
- Have just one-Parent Orientation meeting.
(various requests)

RE Parent Survey

Parent Survey:

What improvements would you like to see for our program? (continued)

- More age-appropriate retreats.
- More relevant, enlivening programs, especially at the younger grades.
- Better methods of communication, i.e., emails.
- More activities for intermediate grade youth beyond what is offered in RE classes.

RE Parent Survey

Parent Survey:

What improvements would you like to see for our program? (continued)

- More youth involvement in/with Mass.
- Classes should be offered on other days also, not only on Sundays.
- Field Trips.
- Not so finite in the rules.
- Offer a variety of class days and times.
- New building with more rooms.

What we need

- We need updated facilities/space that can be used as classrooms and a gathering place. We need “portable” walls, shelves and book cases that can be stored in each room by sliding into storage space(s).
- Updated AV/sound and computer technology.
A good AC system.

What we need

- Facilities that are properly lighted. Tables and chairs that are age appropriate. Teacher file cabinets and desks.
- We also need an announcement system through-out the campus and outdoor areas to be used for emergency announcements.

Our Parish Space Needs:

- Parish Hall, Evangelization, Religious Education, Preschool
- New Building
- Rectory Renovation/Addition

New Community Center / Preschool Building

- **Meets all needs** of Parish
- **Reduces cost** to Parishoners
- Frees up old parish hall again
- Large open space + meeting rooms and classrooms
- No garage planned
- Still need *some* Rectory renovation

Funding by Foundations and Corporations

- **NO:** Churches; Parish Halls
- **YES:** Preschools; Community Centers
- **REDUCES:** Parishoners cost from ~\$5Million to ~\$2.5Million

Old Parish Hall Uses

- Ministries & Administration
- Allocated by **needs** & A/E's sense of **efficiency**

Project Status

- **On hold** until conclusion of this meeting
- This is ***Not*** the Parish's last chance to review and approve

Next Steps with A/E

- Hire
- Meet Parish Ministries and staff
- 5% design (**Concepts**): space allocation; rough floor plan
- 10% design (**Schematics**): rendering, good floor plan + cost estimate

At 10% Design (Schematics)

- Parish and Diocese ***APPROVE*** – or ***NO GO***
- Fundraisers use Schematics (10%) cost estimate to determine feasibility to raise funds
- With all “**Green Lights**” – Raise **Funds**, Finish ***Design*** and ***Build!***
